For the next three hours, Coratelli-Smith and Karg, teaching partners in Naples, took the group through several levels of energy transfer and healing, beginning with learning to sense your own energy, learning how to sense the energy of others, and self-healing.

They taught deep-breathing techniques, and provided a few minutes of meditation.

The healing party culminated with a healing circle, in which members of the group offered healing requests for others and received hands-on healing from the practitioners.
