- Become a Student Member of NFSH-The Healing Trust.
- Attend Healer Development Training Parts 1 & 2, 3 and 4.
- Maintain Student Member Log Book recording experience practicing Contact Healing, etc.
- Familiarize yourself with The Healing Trust Code of Conduct.
- Attend Energy Healing Practice Sessions & Volunteer at Community Healing Sessions.
- Practice Contact Healing and Distant Healing 40 hours of Contact Healing logged.
- Work on clients with Contact Healing and provide 4 references to the NFSH.
- Apply for Healer Member and pass Healer Member Panel on Code of Ethics and demonstrate the Chair Method of Contact Healing (in person or via Skype).
- Purchase appropriate liability insurance.
- Provide appropriate State licensure to perform Energy Healing and touch.

## **Tutor**

You are a Healer Member with NFSH-The Healing Trust with proven teaching skills and wish to develop as Tutor or to assist NFSH-The Healing Trust Tutors.

- Repeat Healer Training Parts 1 & 2, 3 and 4 over a 2 year period, building class development materials.
- Develop, Market and Conduct with your Tutor Mentors "Intro Sessions" to our Healer Development Training attracting new students.
- Apprentice and share costs with other Tutors, developing and presenting class sessions at Healer Development Training. Tutor feedback and progress reports will be provided.
- Organize and conduct Healing Circles in the Community.
- Apply for Tutor Member and pass Tutor Member Panel demonstrate ability to teach Healer Development Training classes.
